Just for example Madam highlighted Intrauterine foetal nourishment with Kedar Kulya Nyaya, Transformation of Carbohydrate to glucose is one way to understand Kshir dadhi nyaya etc. Many such basic and practical examples made the topic interesting and complicated concept was simplified. First session started at 9.30 am and ends at 10.45 am.
